**Purchase Offer “Q”
Purchase of Power from Qualifying Facility**

This tariff will be offered subject to:

1. Standard Jackson County Rural Electric membership requirements.
2. Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission Rules and Regulations of Service for Electric Utilities in Indiana.
3. Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission Rules and Regulations with respect to Cogeneration and Alternate Energy.
4. A contract between the qualifying facility, Jackson County Rural Electric, and Hoosier Energy, Inc. setting forth all terms and conditions governing the interconnection and the purchase of electric power from the qualifying facility.
5. The terms and conditions contained in Hoosier Energy’s Schedule “QF”, a copy of which is attached.

Background: Under terms of an all-requirements contract, Jackson County Rural Electric purchases one hundred percent (100%) of its wholesale power from Hoosier Energy, Inc., a not-for-profit power-supply cooperative headquartered in Bloomington, IN. Consequently, any purchase of power from a qualifying facility would be made by Hoosier Energy on behalf of Jackson County Rural Electric according to the terms of Hoosier Energy’s Schedule “QF”, which was developed to comply with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission’s regulations adopted for the implementation of Section 210 of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act (PURPA 210) relating to the purchase and sale of Energy and Capacity from qualifying generating facilities (co-generators and small power producers).
